PRESIDENT'S TRAVELS

1) Rotaractors from District 3450 (Hong Kong, Macau, and Mongolia) attend the 2014 InterCity Meeting in Hong Kong with RI President Gary C.K. Huang.
2) The Rotary Club of Taipei Mingmen and District 3480 (Taiwan) hosted a *Light Up Rotary* Charity Marathon event, which drew more than 5,500 people. More than US\$10,000 went to Good Shepherd Social Welfare Services, an organization that offers help to women and children in crisis. **3)** Huang and his wife, Corinna Yao, start the *Light Up Rotary* Charity Marathon.



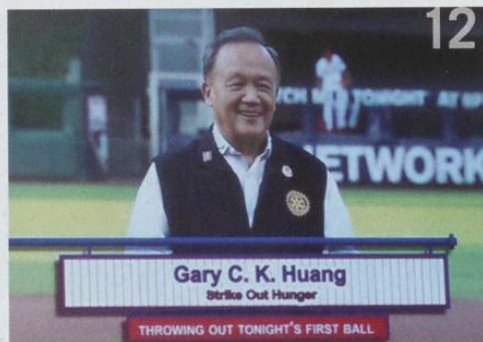
4) During a visit to California, Huang (with U.S. Representative Ed Royce, center, and Peter Pirritano, past president of the Rotary Club of Walnut Valley (Diamond Bar), left) spoke about the importance of eradicating polio. He thanked Royce for being an advocate for the fight to end the disease. **5)** The Walnut Valley (Diamond Bar) club hosted a reception at the Diamond Bar Golf Course for Huang. During the meeting, Pirritano and Huang persuaded Royce to become a Rotarian. **6)** Royce receives an award from Huang for his efforts to end polio. **7)** Huang and Yao stand by the Paul Harris marker outside a hotel in Washington, D.C., part of the Extra Mile – Points of Light Volunteer Pathway. The series of bronze medallions was unveiled along a 1-mile stretch of downtown, several blocks east of the White House. The Extra Mile honors Americans who turned their dreams of helping others into movements that have created lasting change. Paul Harris is one of 33 individuals honored.

Huang, along with hundreds of Rotaractors, attended this year's event in Toronto and Montreal. During the 2011 Interota conference in Hurghada, Egypt, Rotaractors from Districts 7040, 7070, and 7080 launched a successful campaign to host the 2014 event, competing against six other bids: Hong Kong, Poland, Ghana, Lebanon, Greece, and Nigeria.

Huang traveled from Taiwan to attend the event. **12)** At a Philadelphia Phillies baseball game, Huang threw out the first pitch. Thousands of Rotarians attended the 30th annual Strike-Out Hunger game, against the Houston Astros. Strike-Out Hunger was founded by Jacob Neufeld, a 23-year-old Rotarian at the time, and has collected thousands of pounds of food and raised more than \$500,000 for polio eradication. This year, the Phillies donated \$9 to PolioPlus for every ticket sold by Rotarians. **13)** At a Rotary Day event in Manila, Huang gathers with Philippine district governors. Huang invited each of their spouses to become Rotarians.
